5. New conclusions of the dissertation:

* *Firstly:* The dissertation develops and refines the theory of public investment capital and its management in the military. It establishes a concept and clarifies the specific characteristics of public investment capital in the military. It develops a concept of public investment capital management in the military; systematizes the principles, tools, and methods of public investment capital management associated with military and national defense specifics. It clarifies the content of public investment capital management in the military, including: (i) Decentralization of public investment capital management; (ii) Planning of public investment capital; (iii) Execution of public investment capital plans; (iv) Settlement of public investment capital; (v) Inspection and supervision of public investment capital implementation.

* *Secondly:* The dissertation develops a system of qualitative and quantitative criteria for evaluating public investment capital management in the military. The quantitative criteria include: (1) Criteria for evaluating public investment capital planning; (2) Criteria for evaluating implementation of public investment capital plans; (3) Criteria for evaluating public investment capital settlement; and (4) Criteria for evaluating inspection and supervision of public investment capital. It identifies objective and subjective factors affecting public investment capital management in the military.

* *Thirdly:* This dissertation studies the current state of public investment management in the Air Defense - Air Force Command, Ministry of National Defense of Vietnam, focusing on five aspects: (i) Decentralization of public investment management; (ii) Public investment planning; (iii) Implementation of

public investment plans; (iv) Settlement of public investment; and (v) Inspection and supervision of public investment. From this, it provides accurate assessments of the research situation in terms of: achievements, some limitations, and identifies the causes of those limitations.

* *Fourly*: The dissertation proposes 05 solutions to improve the management of public investment capital in the Air Defense - Air Force Command by 2030, with a vision to 2035: (1) Strengthen decentralization associated with accountability in the management of public investment capital; (2) Improve the quality of public investment capital planning; (3) Strengthen discipline and order in the implementation of public investment capital plans; (4) Improve the quality of public investment capital settlement; (5) Strengthen inspection and supervision of public investment capital implementation.

Furthermore, The dissertation proposes a group of supporting solutions: Strengthening the creation of public investment capital; Improving the quality of acceptance testing and quality management of construction projects; Solutions from the perspective of investors in the Air Defense - Air Force Command; Training and enhancing the professional capacity of officials involved in managing public investment capital; Reforming administrative procedures, promoting digital transformation and applying information technology in public investment capital management. In addition, the thesis also proposes several recommendations to the National Assembly, the Government, and the Ministry of National Defense. These solutions and recommendations are based on theoretical and practical foundations, consistent with the State's and the Ministry of National Defense's policies and orientations for managing public investment capital in the future.
